Flu Mist: helps prevent influenza virus (flu). Children without medical problems and no history of asthma (wheezing) who are 2 years and older can get the nasal spray vaccine.	Seasonal: Fall	n/a	\$0

Hepatitis A: helps prevent a liver disease caused by the hepatitis A virus (HAV). Good personal hygiene and proper sanitation can also help prevent the spread of hepatitis A. (2 dose series, with 6-12months between doses).	\$ 61.00	\$ 104.00	\$0
Hepatitis B: vaccine helps prevent this viral infection that affects the liver. Hep B is easily spread through contact with the blood or other body fluids of an infected person. People can also be infected from contact with a contaminated object, where the virus can live for up to 7 days. 3 dose series.	\$ 49.00	\$ 90.00	\$0
Hib –protects against Hib disease-- a serious illness caused by the bacteria <i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> type b. Babies and children younger than 5 years old are most at risk for Hib disease. It can cause lifelong disability and be deadly.	\$ 46.00	n/a	\$0
HPV (Gardasil®): Human Papillomavirus (HPV) is a common virus that is spread through sexual contact. Vaccine works by preventing the most common types of HPV that cause cervical cancer and genital warts. It is given as a 3-dose vaccine, ages 9-26.	\$ 198.00	\$ 198.00	\$0
MMR: helps prevent measles, mumps, and rubella (German measles)	\$ 95.00	\$ 95.00	\$0

Meningococcal (Menactra®): helps prevent a very serious bacterial infection caused by <i>Neisseria meningitidis</i> (routine at ages 11-12 and 2nd dose at age 16-18; guidelines exist for other ages when underlying chronic medical issues exist.	\$ 168.00	\$ 168.00	\$0

Pneumonia (PCV-13®): Helps prevent pneumococcal disease, an infection caused by <i>Streptococcus pneumoniae</i> bacteria (sometimes referred to as pneumococcus). Pneumococcus can cause many types of illnesses, including ear infections and meningitis. Routine series of 4 doses in early childhood	\$ 231.00	n/a	\$0
Pneumonia (Pneumovax® aka PPV23) (recommended at age 65): guidelines exist for other ages when underlying chronic medical issues exist.	\$ 104.00	\$ 104.00	n/a
Polio : helps prevent polio--an infectious disease caused by a virus that lives in the throat and intestinal tract. It is most often spread through person-to-person contact with the stool of an infected person and may also be spread through oral/nasal secretions. Routine series of 4 or 5 doses in early childhood.	\$ 57.00	\$ 57.00	\$0
Rotavirus : helps prevent Rotavirus--the leading cause of severe acute gastroenteritis (vomiting and severe diarrhea) among children worldwide. (Oral vaccine @ age 2mos., 4mos, & 6mos)	\$ 119.00	n/a	\$0
Rabies ; 3 dose pre-exposure series recommended for travelers to high risk international areas; Post Exposure to animal bite or scratch as collaboration after initial visit to ER for wound care, Rabies Immune Globulin and first dose of Rabies vaccine.	\$ 302.00	\$ 302.00	Not available
Shingles (Zostavax) : helps prevent herpes zoster--a painful localized skin rash often with blisters caused by the varicella zoster virus (VZV), the same virus that causes chickenpox. Anyone who has had chickenpox can develop shingles because VZV remains in the nerve cells of the body after the chickenpox infection clears and VZV can reappear years later causing shingles. Tetanus/Diphtheria (Td) : vaccine given to adolescents and adults as a booster shot every 10 years, or after an exposure to tetanus under some circumstances (ages 7-18).	\$ 48.00	\$ 48.00	\$0
