Cost

No cost for patients with:

- Medicaid (Health First Colorado)
- Medicare
- Most private insurances



No insurance?

Your employer may cover your flu shot. Ask your HR manager. SJBPH provides vaccines for uninsured adults and children.

Who should get the flu shot?

Everyone. If you have small children or are an older adult it is even more important you get the flu shot this year.
