Income dependent

Benefits include:

- Periodontal scaling*
- Other procedures*

CHP+

(Child Health Plans Plus)

Income dependent

Age 18 and under & pregnant women age 19+

Benefits include:

- Annual dental exams and cleanings
- Diagnostic and restorative services
- Other preventative services
- Root Canals*
- Crowns*
- Gum and oral surgery procedures*
- Other procedures*

*Prior authorization required.

TIPS

- If uninsured or under-insured, ask your dentist about financing options like payment plans or care credit.
- Consider insurance plans on the Colorado marketplace.
